

## Intensive Course List of Attendee Equipment

Please bring items marked in **Red** for use in the classroom and site work. Items marked with an ( \* ) are optional. Any items you bring with you can be stored in a locked vehicle as the classroom is an exterior pavilion at the Mercer Botanic Gardens. We suggest that you bring your own backpack. Note we will not be returning to the hotel until the end of the night sessions; bring anything you need (including clothing) for the duration of the day.

### Supplied for you:

- 'Sharpie' type waterproof marking pens (Supplied)
- Phillips and Flathead Screwdrivers (Supplied)
- Channel locks (Supplied)
- Set of Allen Head Screw Drivers (Supplied)
- Wire Strippers (Supplied)
- Digital Volt Meter (Supplied)
- Tool box to hold all equipment (Supplied for each group)

### Please bring the following with you:

- Sketch paper, notebook, drawing pencils, and colored pencils or markers/colored pens
- Head lamp (with white light and red/green ) and flashlight including spare batteries or charger
- Laser pointer
- Garden knee pads or kneeling pad
- **HEAVY LEATHER GLOVES** – bring a pair that fit you as fixtures can get very hot.
- **Reusable masks** (please be prepared with a minimum of 4 per day, once they are wet with rain or breath moisture, they are not effective against COVID 19)
- **Comfortable clothes including a hat, sunscreen, umbrella, comfortable outside sneakers or boots (waterproof boots), sweater, jacket, and rain jacket/poncho** – you will be at the site from morning until evening each day. Typically, Houston has warm weather during the day (upper 60's F) and cool evenings (lower 50's F), consider bringing a change of clothes for the evenings.
- **Thermos / travel mug** (ILLI provides a refillable water bottle)
- **The Landscape Lighting Book, 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition** – you will need to reference this during the course.
- **\*Laptop or tablet / ipad** – It isn't necessary for everyone in each group to have a computer, so, if you don't have one, don't worry!
- **\*Camera & Tripod** – if you want to learn/practice landscape lighting photography please bring them with you.
